Artie F. Hampton, 90, of Bloomington passed away on Wednesday, April 23, 2014 at the Residence at McCormick's Creek.

Artie was born in Brown County on May 23, 1923 to Flemon and Mary (Bainbridge) Hampton. He was a World War II Navy Veteran having served in the USS Fremont where he was the ships boxing champ and also served on the USS Chesterfield County. He married Ada M. Helms on February 7, 1942. Artie worked as a farmer and owned his own heating and cooling business, was an electrician, and worked at the MCCSC School Corporation.
