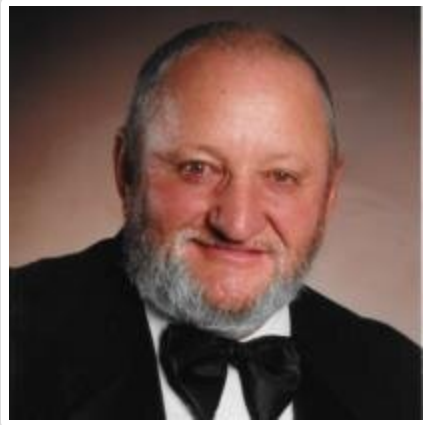




Fred J. Finn

Fred J. Finn 71 of Ellettsville passed away on Monday, October 24, 2016 doing what he loved to do, cutting wood.

Born July 30, 1945 in Ellettsville, the son of Charles B. and Beulah (Rogers) Finn. Fred worked for the Rogers Group for over 40 years, he was a member of the Ellettsville Masonic Lodge #245, Christian Tabernacle in Bloomington and also had attended the Ellettsville First Assembly of God. 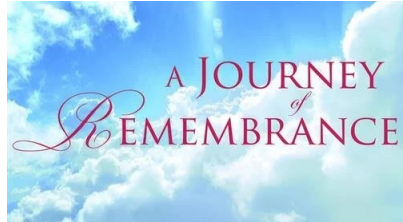
