Jim W. Runyon of Bloomington passed away at his home on Friday, March 14, 2014 at the age of 66.

He was born in Bloomington on April 8, 1947 into the home of Carl and Lucille (Honeycutt) Runyon. He served in the US Air Force in the late 1960's.
