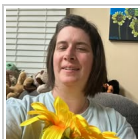
Laura Beth Roemer Bohall, 30, of Bloomington passed away at her home on Sunday, February 10, 2013.

Her family will be observing a private ceremony.

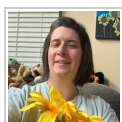
