Mildred Smith, 90, of Bloomington, formally from Gosport, passed away on Monday, November 17, 2014 at her residence.

She was born on July 6, 1924 in Gosport to Fred and Gysie McCullough who preceded her in death. On November 28, 1947, she married Homer David Smith in Gosport. He preceded her in death on April 14, 1993. After graduation from Indiana Central Business College in Indianapolis, Mildred worked at Citizens Gas and Coke Utility in Indianapolis. After marrying Homer David she helped him on the farm until she started working at Owen County Soil and Water Conservation in 1974, retiring in June 1989. She was a member of Gosport Methodist Church. Mildred also belonged to Kappa Kappa Sigma Sorority, Clyde Homemakers' Home Ec, and T.J. Club. Mildred enjoyed gardening and yard work.

Surviving Mildred are her daughters, Kay Terkhorn (Frank) of Bloomington, Karen Hiter (Jim) of Lafayette, Cindy Moog (Joe) of Princeton, and her daughter-in-law, Kathy Smith of Indianapolis. Also surviving are 6 grandchildren, 8 great-grandchildren, brother-in-law, Wilber Asher of Mooresville, and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to her husband she was preceded in death by her son, Stan; her twin sister, Maureen, and a great-grandson, Jace.
