



## Morris Glenn Bristoe

Morris Glenn Bristoe, 77, of Bloomington passed away on Saturday, April 4, 2015 at IU Health-Bloomington Hospital.

He was born in Melber, KY on May 23, 1937 to Jewell and Ophelia (Morris) Bristoe. Morris worked at Illinois Central Railroad in Paducah, KY, Midwest Cable TV in Rapid City, SD and moved to Bloomington in 1966 to work at RCA.
