Ralph L. Moore of Bloomington passed away at his home on Sunday, June 21, 2015 at the age of 79.

He was born in Lawrence County on April 5, 1936 into the home of Ralph W. and Francis Laverne (Rose) Moore. Ralph was a member of the U.S. Navy and served from 1954 to 1958 ending his career at U.S. NAS Fallon in Nevada. He worked for Westinghouse until his retirement after 36 years and served as the President and Vice-President of Union Local 2031 IBEW. Ralph earned the nickname "Speedy" from playing in his high school football team. He was a member of the Bloomington Cruising Classics Car Club and enjoyed pampering and showing his own classic car.
