



## Ronald L. Patton

April 15, 1937 - March 28, 2015

Ronald L. Patton of Gosport passed away at Bloomington Hospice House in the early morning of Saturday, March 28, 2015. He was 77 years old.

Born in Bloomington on April 15, 1937 he was the son of Warren and Stella (Moore) Patton. Ronald served in the US Navy as a Petty Officer 2nd Class on the ship, USS Observation Island just before the Vietnam War. After being honorably discharged he served six years in the National Guard.
