W. Jean (Stevens) Weaver, 84, passed away on Tuesday, October 17, 2017 in hospice care at the Residence of McCormick's Creek. She faced a fast spreading cancer and dementia with the grace and faith that always guided her life.

She was born on November 11, 1932 in Monroe County, Indiana to Herbert and Esther (Lines) Stevens. She graduated from Bloomington High School in 1951. Jean married the love of her life, Wayne Weaver, on Christmas Day, 1952 in Bloomington while he was home on leave from the Army based in Mineral Wells, TX where they made their first home. She volunteered for the Putnam County Family Services, worked at IBM Greencastle, and made the family home a fun, organized and welcoming place to be. Jean was a member of the Gosport Baptist Church, Cloverdale OES, and the Kappa Kappa Sigma sorority.

She was preceded in death by her parents and sister, Wanda Summerall.

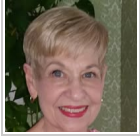
